About AC Cugini

Based in Northern Virginia outside Washington, DC, AC Cugini was founded in 2000 as an official Italian scuola calcio (soccer academy). Cugini has the rare distinction of being the only soccer academy in North America sanctioned by the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI Servizi) and the Italian Soccer Federation (FIGC) and affiliated with professional Italian clubs - Brescia Calcio and club RES Roma Calcio Femminile. Cugini offers year-round training in the United States and Italy, tryout opportunities with professional Italian clubs, and coach education and licensing in Italy.

About Play Soccer in Italy



In 2001, AC Cugini developed an international athletic and educational program, *Play Soccer in Italy*, to further expose American youth to Italian player

development; allow participants the opportunity to add international playing and training experience to their soccer background; offer the most talented players access to talent scouts from professional Italian clubs, and have American families experience the countless wonders of the Italian culture. This highly successful program was an important element of the special recognition that AC Cugini received in 2004 from the Italian National Olympic Committee.

The 2015 Play Soccer in Italy is open to AC Cugini boys and girls ages 10-13. (Note: Girls may play down in age if playing against a boys teams, so 14 year old girls will also be considered). We will also consider players from outside Cugini upon request.

The program includes 7 nights at the beach in Montesilvano on the Italian Adriatic in central Italy; 4 tournament matches; and 2 nights in Rome, with the possibility of a training session with instructors from the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI). All players will be reviewed by talent scouts from various professional Italian mens' and women's' clubs.

As AC Cugini does not chaperone children, each player must be accompanied by their parent or another adult chaperone designated by their parent during the entire trip. Cugini President Fabio Diletti will supervise all players during tournament play or training, Additional family and friends are always welcome to register for the program.

Tour Directors

AC Cugini President Fabio Diletti, a native Italian, is the tour director, along with his wife, Lisa, who is also fluent in Italian. Fabio, who will coach the tournament teams, was born and raised in Ascoli Piceno, in the Marche region of central Italy. A professional trainer and talent scout, Fabio played soccer as a goalkeeper for professional club Ascoli Calcio. A long-time resident of the Washington, DC area, Lisa is a graduate of Georgetown University and a marketing and communications professional who also serves as Cugini's Executive Director. All of Lisa's grandparents were born in Rome and she has spent many years traveling throughout Italy and Europe. Fabio and Lisa met in Italy in 1986 in Bellagio on Lake Como. Two of their children live in Firenze (Florence), including their son Cristian, who coordinates AC Cugini's International Programs from Italy.

Hotels



The tour includes accommodations at 3- and 4-star hotels, as rated by the Italian government. All hotel rooms have private bath, air conditioning, color TV, hairdryer, and minibar.

Room service, minibar charges, and anything else charged to the room (movies, drinks, laundry service, etc.) are extra and must be paid directly to the hotel upon check out. The hotel in Montesilvano is on the beach and includes entrance to private beach plus umbrella and chairs.

Meals

Montesilvano - The rates include breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily at the hotel in Montesilvano. Dinner and lunch are 3-course meals with multiple menu choices of 3 first courses, 3 second courses, dessert/fruit. There is also a vegetable and salad buffet. Mineral water is included in the meals. Sodas and

alcohol are extra and must be paid directly to the hotel.

Roma - Only breakfast is included at the hotel in Rome, which allows families time to dine at their leisure as they tour the Eternal city on their own.



Tournament Location & Facility



Accademia del Calcio Poggio degli Ulivi

Located below the medieval hill town of Città Sant'Angelo, the Accademia del Calcio has been the site of numerous tournaments in which AC Cugini has participated over the years. The facility is equipped with 3 synthetic turf fields with FIGC-approved lighting, grandstand for 1,000 spectators, changing rooms for athletes, restaurant, refreshment stand, and a bar.

Poggio degli Ulivi has been the site of many tournaments and events at the international, national, and regional level with prestigious professional teams participating, such as Roma, Lazio, Juventus, Inter, Bari, Empoli, Fiorentina, Pescara and Chieti.

About Montesilvano



The charming beach resort of Montesilvano is located immediately north of Pescara, on the Italian Adriatic sea in the Abruzzo region of central Italy *(3 hours northeast of Rome)*. The name Montesilvano is derived from the Latin and means woody hill. Montesilvano, is divided into Montesilvano Marina (a lively seaside resort) and Montesilvano Colle (the original medieval comune and citadel). The town has a Mediterranean climate and is surrounded by verdant landscapes covering a vast area filled with exotic vegetation. The coastline ~ 3 miles of clean, white, fine sand beaches, edging up to the crystal azure

water ~ makes it the perfect place to escape and relax. Montesilvano offers the visitor a variety of sporting possibilities ~ from sailing, hand gliding, and water slides to tennis, outdoor roller-skating, and bicycling. and a varied night life with discos, restaurants, and bars, as well as boutiques for shopping and a maritime museum.

Visiting the surrounding area

Families will have plenty of time to explore the area around Montesilvano on their own if they wish. The port town of Pescara is only a few minutes away. Optional group tours to Ascoli Piceno (the hometown of Cugini President Fabio Diletti), a beautiful medieval city one hour from Montesilvano, and to a local vineyard - with a wine tasting for the adults - will also be arranged if there is sufficient group interest.

About Rome



Rome (Roma) is the capital of Italy as well the capital of the Lazio region. It is Italy's largest and most populous city, with more than 2.7 million residents, and a metropolitan area of almost 4 million inhabitants. Situated on the River Tiber, between the Apennine Mountains and the Tyrrhenian Sea, the "Eternal City" was once the administrative center of the mighty Roman Empire, governing a vast region that stretched all the way from Britain to Mesopotamia.

Rome stands on top of more than two and a half thousand years of history; it was once the largest city in the world and the center of Western civilization. Today, Rome is a modern, cosmopolitan

city, and the third most-visited tourist destination in the European Union. Due to its influence in politics, media, the arts and culture, Rome has been described as a global city.

Art and Culture

One of the symbols of Rome is the Colosseum (70–80 AD), the largest amphitheater ever built in the Roman Empire. Originally capable of seating 60,000 spectators, it was used for gladiatorial combat. The list of the very important monuments of ancient Rome includes the Roman Forum, the Domus Aurea, the Pantheon, Trajan's Column, Trajan's Market, the Catacombs, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, Castel Sant'Angelo, the Mausoleum of Augustus, the Ara Pacis, the Arch of Constantine, the Pyramid of Cestius, and the Bocca della Verità. The most important museums and galleries of Rome include the National Museum of Rome, the Museum of Roman Civilization, the Villa Giulia National Etruscan Museum, the Capitoline Museums, the Borghese Gallery, the Museum of Castel Sant'Angelo, and the National Gallery of Modern Art.

TOUR PRICES: The prices cited in this brochure include land package only and are quoted in U.S. dollars. Prices are guaranteed against any fluctuation in the rate of exchange if fully paid by March 1, 2015. After this period, Cugini Soccer Services International (hereinafter referred to as CSSI) reserves the right to adjust the rates accordingly. Also CSSI reserves the right to pass on any increases received from airlines, hotels, ground transportation companies, government taxes, or any other similar services. **A \$250 supplement will apply to all single room requests.**

AIRFARE: Not included.

RESERVATIONS/PAYMENTS: Reservations will be confirmed only after receipt of deposit. **The first deposit** of \$600 is due on January 15, 2015. **The second deposit** of \$600 per person is due by March 1, 2015. **The balance and final payment** is due by May 1, 2015. If deposits are not received on time, CSSI reserves the right to cancel the booking. **Bookings received on/after May 1, 2015** are subject to availability and must be paid in full at time of reservation. Reservations made within 30 days of departure date are subject to an additional \$100 booking fee, plus any costs to ensure timely document delivery.

ACCOMMODATIONS: All accommodations have private bath or shower and air conditioning. Rooms are assigned upon arrival based on current availability and may vary in size, amenities, and location. CSSI reserves the right to change hotels.

MEALS: Only meals as indicated in brochure are included.
